



## VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

There are **three** ways to register to vote in Hanover: (NH does not offer online registration)

1. Register at the Town Office (41 South Main Street), Monday through Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. (No registration available during the seven days prior to any election.)
2. Attend an on-campus voter registration drive.
3. Register on Election Day. *However, it is highly recommended that you register to vote in advance.*

**Note that all students who do not live in Hanover, even if in Dartmouth housing (e.g. Summit on Juniper, Sachem Village), must register to vote in the town in which the residence actually is, e.g. City of Lebanon.**

**To register, each of the three requirements below must be met:**

### For Undergrads Living in Campus Housing:

1. **Proof of Identity and Age:** Dartmouth ID or current driver's license; name must match registrant name. If none are available, an affidavit\* can be completed.
2. **Proof of Citizenship:** Passport/card or birth certificate (paper or digital). If none are available, an affidavit\* can be completed. For naturalized citizens, supply court name, city and date of naturalization.
3. **Proof of Domicile in Hanover:** No action needed: town supervisors will confirm.

### For Undergrads Living Off-Campus:

1. **Proof of Identity and Age:** Dartmouth ID or current driver's license; name must match registrant name. If none are available, an affidavit\* can be completed.
2. **Proof of Citizenship:** Passport/card or birth certificate (paper or digital). If none are available, an affidavit\* can be completed. For naturalized citizens, supply court name, city and date of naturalization.
3. **Proof of Hanover Domicile:** A signed, current lease, or your utility bill with your name on it (paper or digital).. If none are available, an affidavit\* can be completed.

### For Grad Students Living in Campus Housing:

1. **Proof of Identity and Age:** Dartmouth ID or current driver's license; name must match registrant name. If none are available, an affidavit\* can be completed.
2. **Proof of Citizenship:** Passport/card or birth certificate (paper or digital). If none are available, an affidavit\* can be completed. For naturalized citizens, supply court name, city and date of naturalization.
3. **Proof of Hanover Domicile:** Letter/statement from your dean or school confirming that you reside in a Hanover dormitory. If none are available, an affidavit\* can be completed.

### For Grad Students Living Off-Campus:

1. **Proof of Identity and Age:** Dartmouth ID or current driver's license; name must match registrant name. If none are available, an affidavit\* can be completed.
2. **Proof of Citizenship:** Passport/card or birth certificate (paper or digital). If none are available, an affidavit\* can be completed. For naturalized citizens, supply court name, city and date of naturalization.
3. **Proof of Hanover Domicile:** A signed, current lease with your name or a utility bill (paper or digital). If none are available, an affidavit\* can be executed.

*\*An affidavit is a legally binding written statement sworn to or affirmed under oath before an election official, notary public or justice of the peace.*
