# PETITION TO THE HANOVER SELECTBOARD TO INSERT A WARRANT ARTICLE

We, the undersigned registered voters of the Town of Hanover, New Hampshire, request that the Hanover Selectboard insert the following article in the warrant of the 2024 Town Meeting:

By petition of 25 or more eligible voters, to see if the Town will vote to call on the United States government to support an immediate and permanent ceasefire in Gaza and the West Bank in order to ensure the safety and right to life of all people living in the region of Israel and Palestine. Additionally, to stop the ongoing armed hostilities and human devastation, these voters ask the Town of Hanover to urge the United States government to immediately end U.S. arms shipments and military aid to the Israeli government and to use its considerable influence to ensure the safe delivery of food and medical supplies to Gaza. The record of the vote shall be transmitted by written notice from town officials to United States Representative Ann Kuster from New Hampshire; United States Senators Maggie Hassan and Jeanne Shaheen from New Hampshire; and United States President Joseph Biden, urging them to take action toward this end.
